



# PENNSYLVANIA TAXPAYER RELIEF ACT

## Understanding the Attached Chart

**Column “A”** – *Average School Property Tax Bill* – This is the latest data on the average school district property tax bill for a residence in the school district. This may be higher or lower than your tax bill.

**Column “B”** – *Property Tax Rent Rebate Range* – This is the range of property tax and rent rebates (for 2005 taxes) that will become immediately available for those who qualify.

**Column “C”** – *Homestead Exclusion* – This is the estimated amount of the dollar value of the homestead exclusion in that school district, calculated at 35% of the maximum exclusion allowed by law. Each homestead gets the same exclusion in any given district.

**Column “D”** – *EIT Rate Needed* – This is the rate of additional earned income taxes that is necessary to fund the level of homestead exclusion listed in column “C” in that school district. If your school district elects to offer a homestead exclusion higher than the one listed in column “C,” the earned income tax rate will be higher.

**Column “G”** – *Gaming Revenue* – This is the gaming revenue estimated at \$400 million, below Governor Rendell’s figure of \$1 billion. It will not be available this year.

**Column “E”** – *Total Savings Range, High and Low* – This is the range of dollar savings of those who qualify for the property tax and rent rebate **plus** the homestead exclusion, **plus** a payout of \$400 million in gaming revenues.

**Column “F”** – *Total Saving Range* – This is the total savings as set forth in column “E” expressed as a percent of the average school property tax bill in column “A”.
