

# SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

# House Bill 1974 Printer's No. 3139

Prime Sponsor: Representative Longietti Committee: Judiciary

## SYNOPSIS:

This bill amends Title 20 (Decedents, Estates and Fiduciaries) to increase the permitted amount of a decedent's wages that may be paid by an employer to the decedent's family.

# SUMMARY:

Under current law, the employer of a person who dies in Pennsylvania may, regardless of whether a personal representative has been appointed, pay wages, salary, or benefits that were due to the deceased employee in an amount not exceeding \$5,000 to the spouse, any child, the father or mother, or any sibling of the deceased employee. This bill increases the cap on such payments from \$5,000 to \$10,000.

## **EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This bill is effective in 60 days.

## **BILL HISTORY:**
