



SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 1365 Printer's No. 2068

SYNOPSIS:

This bill amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to add common pleas court judgeships to certain judicial districts.

SUMMARY:

The bill adds one new common pleas judgeship each to five counties: Bucks, Cumberland, Montgomery, Washington, and Wayne. In all counties except Cumberland, the new judgeships will be filled by election in 2017 and the new judges will be sworn into office in January 2018. In Cumberland County, the new judgeship will be filled by election in 2019, and the new judge will be sworn into office in January 2020.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This bill is effective immediately.
