



Dear Friend,

## When Visiting the Welcome Center, You Can:






Make a telephone connection to a leader from Pennsylvania's past.


Take part in a debate and cast your vote.

## Access from Third Street (Main Capitol Entrance)

Come through the revolving doors of the Main Entrance, go to the rear of the marble staircase and proceed straight down the hallway until you come to the escalator. Go down the escalator and past the cafeteria, then turn left at the Information Desk to the Welcome Center.

## Access from Commonwealth Avenue (East Wing Entrance)

Come through the doors of the East Wing Entrance past the Information Desk and turn right to the Welcome Center.
