TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2021

Concurrent Resolution voted on Third Consideration:

<u>House Resolution 139</u> (Labs) extends the proclamation declaring a disaster emergency issued by the Governor in response to the aftereffects of Hurricane Ida until October 27, 2021. **Adopted: 49-0.**

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

<u>Senate Bill 318</u> (Scavello) amends Title 34 (Game) to add a falconry exemption for Sunday hunting. **Passed: 47-2.**

<u>Senate Bill 461</u> (Baker) requires Senate confirmation of the Director of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency. <u>Passed: 30-19.</u>

<u>Senate Bill 302</u> (Yaw) establishes the Firefighting Foam Management Act, prohibiting the use of PFAS chemicals for training or testing, and providing for warning labels. <u>Passed: 39-10.</u>

Bills amended on Third Consideration:

<u>Senate Bill 709</u> (Tomlinson) establishes the Cytomegalovirus Education and Newborn Screening Act. <u>Amended and Over.</u>

<u>A02280</u> (Tomlinson) allows testing approved on or before the effective date by either the Department of Health or the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to be used. **Agreed To.**

<u>Senate Bill 739</u> (Stefano) amends Title 35 to allow municipal-owned fire companies to participate in the Fire & EMS Loan Program. <u>Amended and Over.</u>

<u>A01942</u> (Stefano) removes a representative of the Fireman's Association of the State of Pennsylvania from the application review committee. <u>Agreed To.</u>

Bills Voted on Third Consideration:

<u>Senate Bill 552</u> (Dush) amends the Right-to-Know Law to add a new section on vexatious requesters. **Passed: 34-15.**
