Monday, October 18, 2021

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

<u>SB 224</u> (BARTOLOTTA) amends the Public School Code to repeal and replace provisions related to out-of-state. **PASSED: 48-0.**

SB 780 (PITTMAN) designates the Sergeant Charles R. Learn Memorial Bridge in Indiana County. PASSED: 48-0.

SB 847 (MENSCH) designates the Dr. Frank Erdman Boston Memorial Highway in Montgomery County. **PASSED: 48-0.**

Resolution adopted:

SR 164 (ROBINSON) A concurrent resolution urging the U.S. Navy and the U.S. Marine Corps to hold their 250th Birthday Celebration in the City of Philadelphia. **AMENDED AND ADOPTED: 48-0.**

A02580 changes "authorizes" to "urge" AGREED TO.

Tuesday, October 19, 2021

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

SB 157 (MENSCH) establishes the First-Time Home Buyer Savings Account Act. PASSED: 46-3.

<u>SB 603</u> (BROOKS) amends the Public School Code to establish procedures for removing a tick from a student and provide information on Lyme disease. <u>PASSED: 48-1.</u>

<u>SB 777</u> (LANGERHOLC) amends Title 75 to exempt the five newest model year vehicles from the emissions test, and to remove the gas cap testing requirement for subject vehicles without a gas cap. **PASSED: 29-20.**

<u>SB 786</u> (AUMENT) amends the Public School Code to permit additional school entities to participate in an open campus initiative. **PASSED: 29-20.**
