### Monday, November 8, 2021

### **Bills voted on Third Consideration:**

<u>HB 416</u> (QUINN) Amends the Public School Code of 1949 to provide for seizure recognition and related first aid training. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

<u>SB 849</u> (STEFANO) Amends Title 51 to clarify that veterans with a medical discharge receive Veterans' Preference. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

#### **Resolutions:**

<u>SR 53</u> (BAKER) Directs the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to issue a report on the effectiveness of the Department of Transportation's ("Department") highway maintenance funding formula. **ADOPTED 49-0.** 

SR 195 (PHILIPS-HILL) Urges U.S. Congress to oppose requiring financial institutions from having to report the gross inflows and outflows of business and personal bank accounts to the Internal Revenue Service. AMENDED AND ADOPTED 29-20.

 A02885 (PHILIPS-HILL) Removes references to a specific dollar amount an instead refers to common amounts. ADOPTED 29-20

# Tuesday, November 9, 2021

#### Bills voted on Third Consideration:

<u>SB 347</u> (**DISANTO**) Amends the Tax Reform Code of 1971, to allow for the like-kind exchange of real property. <u>PASSED 33-17.</u>

<u>SB 470</u> (**DUSH**) Designates the CPT Harry "Bud" Hetrick Memorial Bridge in Jefferson County. <u>OVER AS</u> **AMENDED.** 

• A00649 (DUSH) Technical amendment. AGREED TO.

#### Bills voted on Supplemental:

<u>SB 448</u> (LANGERHOLC) Amends Title 18 and Title 53 to reinforce preemption of local regulations on firearms and ammunition, and to provide relief for a person or membership organization adversely affected by a local action in violation of preemption. **PASSED 31-19.** 

<u>SB 565</u> (**DUSH**) Amends Title 18 by eliminating the need to obtain a license to carry a firearm in any vehicle or to carry a concealed firearm. Provides for an optional concealed carry license and retains the sportsman's firearm permit. **PASSED 29-21.** 

### Bill amended on Supplemental:

<u>SB 830</u> (YUDICHAK) Amends Title 64 to establish the Veteran-owned Business Loan Guarantee Program within the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA). <u>OVER AS AMEDED.</u>

A02908 (YUDICHAK) Technical amendment. AGREED TO.

## Wednesday, November 10, 2021

#### **Bills voted on Third Consideration:**

**SB 140 (BROWNE)** Amends the Election Code to require the electronic filing of campaign finance reports. **PASSED 49-0.** 

<u>SB 470</u> (**DUSH**) Designates the CPT Raymond Harry "Bud" Hetrick Memorial Bridge in Jefferson County. **PASSED 49-0.** 

<u>SB 755</u> (KEARNEY) Amends the Municipalities Planning Code to authorize the electronic transmission of certain planning and land use documents by a municipality. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

**SB 830 (YUDICHAK)** Amends Title 64 to establish the Veteran-owned Business Loan Guarantee Program within the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA). **PASSED 49-0.** 

SB 915 (BROWNE) The Capital Budget Project Itemization Act of FY 2021-2022. PASSED 49-0.

<u>HB 1107</u> (WHEELAND) Designates the Sgts. Thomas Woodruff, Sr., and Hamilton Woodruff Memorial Interchange in Lycoming County. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

HB 1120 (TOPPER) Designates the PFC James E. Williams Memorial Bridge in Bedford County. PASSED 49-0.

# Bill voted on Supplemental:

<u>SB 248</u> (PHILIPS-HILL) Amends title 38 by establishing March 6th as "Persian Gulf War Veterans Day" and October 7th as "Global War on Terrorism Veterans Day". <u>HOUSE AMENDMENTS CONCURRED IN</u> 49-0.
