

**PACE and PACENET** benefits are available to older Pennsylvanians who have reached the age of 65 and are on a limited income. These programs provide generic and brand name prescription drugs at a minimal cost to you.

### Requirements and Benefits

#### PACE

- 65 years of age or older.
- A resident of Pennsylvania for at least 90 days prior to the date of your application.
- Not receiving prescription benefits under Medical Assistance.
- Total annual income for a SINGLE person: \$14,500 or less\*.
- Total annual income for a MARRIED couple: \$17,700 or less\*.
- As a PACE Card holder you pay a \$6.00 co-payment for each generic drug prescription and \$9.00 for each name-brand drug prescription.



#### **PACENET**

- 65 years of age or older.
- A resident of Pennsylvania for at least 90 days prior to the date of your application.

Income eligibility

- Not receiving prescription benefits under Medical Assistance.
- Total annual income for a SINGLE person up to \$33,500\*.
- Total annual income for a MARRIED couple is up to \$41,500\*.
- Once an application is approved, an enrollee
  - is responsible for a monthly premium before the program will begin reimbursing prescriptions.
- Once an enrollee meets the premium, they are responsible for an \$8.00 co-payment for generic prescription drugs and a \$15.00 co-payment for brand name prescription drugs.
- \* Applicants whose income is less than fifty cents over these limits may round down to the eligibility limits.
