Monday, February 7, 2022

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

SB 327 (J. WARD) Amends the County Code, to provide for notification of death to the county coroner. **PASSED 33-16.**

<u>SB 807</u> (J. WARD) Amends Title 57 to eliminate an obsolete fee and provide greater flexibility for county officers to register the signature of a notary public. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

Bills amended on Third Consideration and voted on Supplemental:

HB 1082 (DELROSSO) Establishes the Early Detection and Diagnosis of Alzheimer's Disease or Related Disorder Act. **PASSED WITH AMENDMENT 49-0.**

<u>A03637</u> (K. WARD) Provides for a technical change to the definition of high medical assistance hospital to align with the definition contained in our state Medicaid Plan. **AGREED TO**.

Bills voted on Supplemental:

SB 739 (STEFANO) Amends Title 35 by adding additional organizations to the application review committee for the 2% Fire and EMS Loan Program. HOUSE AMENDMENTS CONCURRED IN 49-0.

Tuesday, February 8, 2022

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

SB 866 (PITTMAN) Designates the Carl E. Keith Memorial Bridge in Indiana County. PASSED 49-0.

SB 891 (PITTMAN) Designates the Sergeant First Class ("SFC") Randy McCaulley Memorial Bridge in Indiana County. PASSED 49-0.

Wednesday, February 9, 2022

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

SB 1020 (GEBHARD) Authorizes a conveyance of land in Union Township, Lebanon County. PASSED 49-0.

HB 2143 (RYAN) Amends Title 61 to require certain Second Class A counties to be governed by the prison board, provisions currently applicable to counties of the third through fifth class. PASSED 49-0.

Bills voted on Supplemental:

<u>SB 739</u> (STEFANO) Amends Title 35 to allow municipal-owned fire companies to participate in the Fire & EMS Loan Program; and establishes the COVID-19 Recovery Grant Program. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

HB 232 (MUSTELLO) Amends the Public School Code to provide a process for a school district to change its name. PASSED 49-0.

Resolution voted on Supplemental:

HR 173 (BOBACK) Extends the disaster emergency declaration of January 28, 2022 for the collapse of the Forbes Avenue/Fern Hollow Bridge. ADOPTED 49-0.

Various Nominations of the Governor. **CONFIRMED.**
