Bill voted on Third Consideration:

SB 1094 (GEBHARD) Amends Title 75 (Vehicles) modernize the Motor Carrier Safety Advisory Committee (MCSAC). **PASSED 49-0.**

A04699 (MUTH) Adds an addition four members to the MCSAC. FAILED 21-28.

Bills amended on Third Consideration and voted on Supplemental:

<u>SB 522</u> (BAKER) Creates the Childhood Blood Lead Test Act requiring prenatal patients and all children (at one and two years of age) to receive a blood lead level test and to require the tests to be covered by a health insurance policy. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

A04696 (BAKER) Requires healthcare providers to make reasonable efforts to ensure patients receive a blood lead test, increases the age by which a blood test should be taken from between 9-12 mounts to by 24 months, inserts exposure risk assessment and testing requirements relating to pregnant women. ADOPTED 33-16.

<u>HB 2496</u> (BOBACK) Authorizes DGS to conduct two land conveyances, one located in Wyoming County and the other located in Allegheny County. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

A04336 (STREET) Authorization for release of restriction in Philadelphia County. AGREED TO.

Bill voted on Supplemental:

SB 1027 (STEFANO) Amends the Child Labor Act to permit Junior Firefighters to train on live burn modules. **PASSED 49-0.**

Motion to call up Discharge Resolution:

Discharge Resolution No. 2 to consider <u>SB134</u> (FONTANA) An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) providing for extreme risk protection orders. <u>FAILED 21-28.</u>

Tuesday, June 14, 2022

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

<u>SB 811</u> (FONTANA) Amends the Municipal Claim and Tax Lien Law to allow cities of the second class and counties of the second class the ability to acquire property at sheriff sales. <u>PASSED 49-0.</u>

SB 1159 (BROOKS) Amends the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act to extend the temporary COVID-19 small games provisions for club licensees through December 31, 2022. **PASSED 49-0.**

SB 1208 (BROWNE) Amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to allow for the use of debit cards for payment of court costs, restitution and fines. **PASSED 49-0.**

<u>SB 1237</u> (VOGEL) Amends Title 3 (Agriculture) to extend the existing temporary horse racing regulations by three years and provides the Horse Racing Commission the authority to issue temporary regulations in compliance with forthcoming federal regulations. **PASSED 48-1.**

Bill amended on Second Consideration

<u>SB 892</u> (LAUGHLIN) Amends Title 75 (Vehicles) to create an electric low-speed scooter (e-scooter) pilot program in a city of the second class A and third class. <u>OVER AS AMENDED.</u>

<u>A04436</u> (LAUGHLIN) Changes the age from 16 to 18 and adds authority for local jurisdictions to restrict usage based on safety concerns. <u>ADOPTED 48-1.</u>

Bill voted on Supplemental

SB 1100 (Browne) General Appropriations Act of 2022. PASSED 48-1.

Motion to call up Discharge Resolution:

Discharge Resolution No. 1: SB88 (HUGHES) An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) to provide for sale or transfer of firearms. **FAILED 21-28.**

Wednesday, June 15, 2022

Bills voted on Third Consideration:

<u>SB 447</u> (Brooks) Amends the Tax Reform Code of 1971, to incrementally reduce the corporate net income tax. **PASSED 31-19.**

A04694 (MUTH) Adds a requirement for combined reporting. FAILED 20-30.

<u>SB 617</u> (Tartaglione) Establishes the Pennsylvania Family and Medical Leave Act providing for family and medical leave for eligible employees. <u>PASSED 47-3.</u>

<u>SB 669</u> (**REGAN**) Amends Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) to provide full-time police officers with the option to purchase up to five years of pension service credit for prior part-time or full-time service. **PASSED 48-2.**

SB 771 (AUMENT) Amends the Tax Reform Code by providing for a reduction in the corporate net income tax rate. **PASSED 31-19.**

A04266 (MUTH) Adds a requirement for combined reporting. FAILED 20-30.

SB 1052 (HUTCHINSON) Amends Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) to revise the emergency powers provisions to allow a municipality to establish a temporary meeting location during an emergency that renders holding meetings at the ordinary location unsafe, hazardous, or impossible. It additionally allows quorum to be met through attendance via a telecommunications device. PASSED 50-0.

SB 1199 (ROBINSON) Amends the Port of Pittsburgh Commission Act to update the composition of the Port of Pittsburgh Commission. **PASSED 50-0.**

<u>HB 1849</u> (POLINCHOCK) Amends the Real Estate Licensing and Registration Act to provide for distance education. PASSED 50-0.

Bills amended and voted on Supplemental:

<u>SB 691</u> (**GORDNER**) Amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to add a second judge to the Court of Common Pleas in the Twentieth Judicial District and a third judge to the Court of Common Pleas in the Twenty-sixth Judicial District. <u>PASSED 50-0.</u>

A04671 (COMMITTA) Adds a judge in both the Fifteenth and Twenty-sixth judicial districts. AGREED TO.

SB 967 (SCHWANK) Establishes the Women, Infants and Children State Advisory Board. PASSED 49-1.

A04774 (SCHWANK) Provides for some definitions and streamlines some of the board's duties. AGREED TO.

Bill voted on Concurrence in House Amendments on Supplemental:

SB 915 (BROWNE) Capital Budget Project Itemization Act of 2021-2022 CONCURRED IN HOUSE AMENDMENTS 50-0.
